



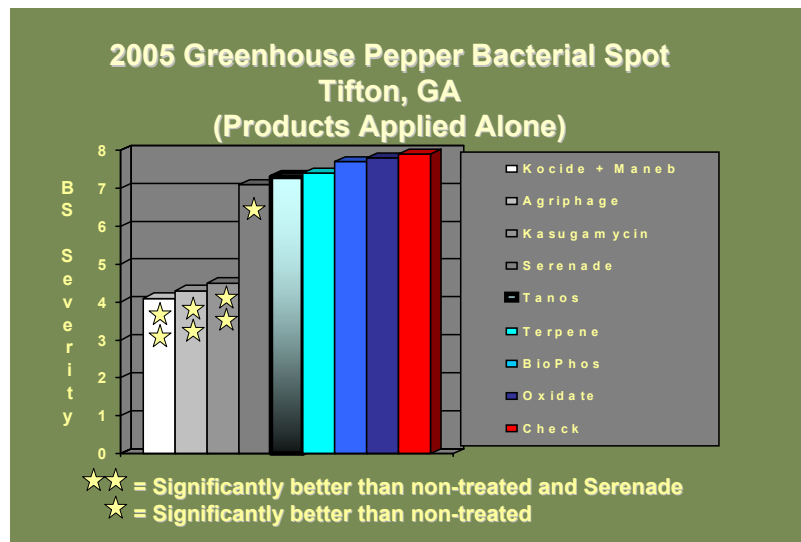

Trial: Bacteria control on greenhouse pepper

In Fall of 2005, Lewis Taylor Farms performed a greenhouse trial in cooperation with Dr. David Langston of the University of GA, in order to determine the effectiveness of various bacteria control products on pepper. He tested 8 different products, with one control.

When the products were applied alone, these are the results:



*Rating scale is 1=little disease spread, 10=100% spread
 Ratings taken by three separate people, then results were compared for consistency*

This clearly shows that AgriPhage is an effective bacteria control for bacteria that is sensitive to copper. Based on feedback from various universities throughout the east, it is estimated that more than 70% of the bacteria causing spot in tomato and pepper is resistant to copper treatments. This concludes that AgriPhage is the most-effective bacteria control product available, especially for copper-resistant strains of bacteria.
